Welcome to the MMFA! The Museum is a public institution with five pavilions, each of which has collections and exhibitions distributed over several levels.



The Museum also houses a café, a Boutique and Bookstore, an Art Hive, art workshops and spots to rest and reflect.

Depending on the time of day, the galleries and other spaces can be quiet and calm or busy and packed with people.

This visual breakdown will help you prepare for your group visit.

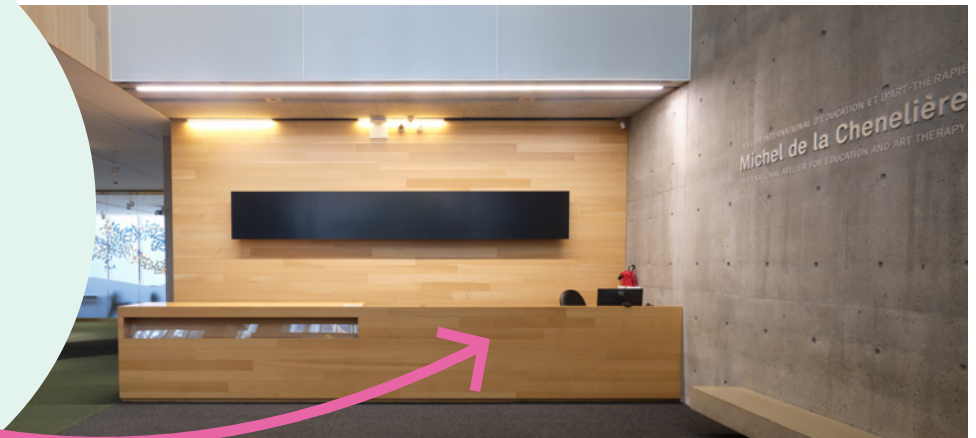
It maps out the entire visit, from the Museum's entrance up to the point you meet with the person from the Museum who will serve as your guide.

The group entrance is located at 2075 Bishop Street.

This entrance is wheelchair-accessible.

Once inside, you will find a reception desk directly in front of you.

Someone will be there to greet you and verify your reservation.



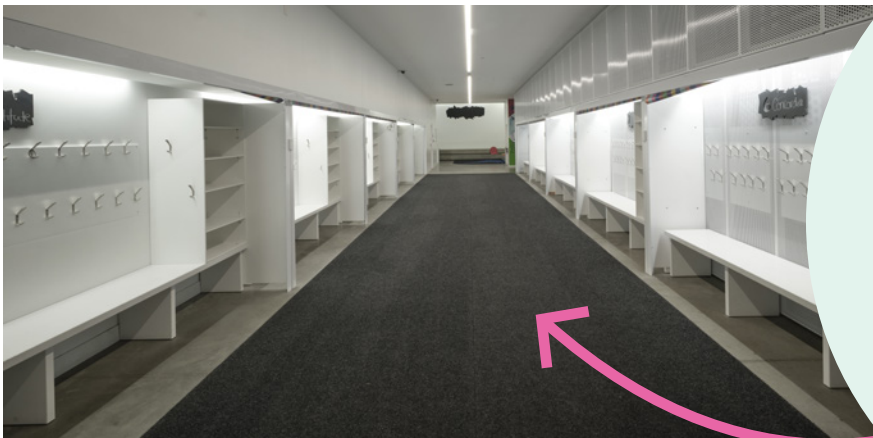
Elevators and washrooms can be found behind the reception desk.
